Motown and More! -From The Temptations to Lizzo

(DENVER, CO) January 1, 2020 — The Denver Gay Men's Chorus is thrilled to present its 38th annual Spring concert, ***Motown and More! From The Temptations to Lizzo*** on March 6th in Brighton, on March 13th and 14th in downtown Denver and on March 18th in Littleton..

Under the creative leadership of Artistic and Managing Director James Knapp, Colorado's premier LGBTQ performing arts ensemble will celebrate a half-century of iconic African American pop music that has its roots in the distinctive sounds of the Motor City and now permeates every genre of popular music today. Audiences will enjoy classic hits by some of our greatest American artists, such as Smokey Robinson, Marvin Gaye, The Temptations, Stevie Wonder, Diana Ross and The Supremes, and the incomparable Queen of Soul, Aretha Franklin; as well as a medley of tunes from the era of Disco Fever that swept the nation in the 1970s; and music by some of today's biggest artists, including Beyonce, Bruno Mars, and Lizzo. Whether your preferred musical style includes some smooth choreographed steps by The Temptations, THINK from Aretha, the driving rhythms of Tina Turner's *Proud Mary*, a severe case of *Boogie Fever*, or the hip lyrics of Bruno Mars' *Uptown Funk*, this concert performed by the 120 voices of The Denver Gay Men's Chorus with a smokin' hot band is guaranteed to provide audiences with two hours of nonstop entertainment. You might even leave this show to go *Dancing in the Streets!*

Denver performances on March 13th and 14th will take place at The Ellie Caulkins Opera House in partnership with Denver Arts and Venues, in the Denver Performance Arts Complex (DPAC), 1385 Curtis Street, Denver, CO 80204. Performances are at **7:30 pm each night**, with an additional matinee performance at **2:00 pm** on March 14th which will be ASL-interpreted.

The Littleton performance on March 18th at 8:00 p.m. will take place at the Waring Theater in Arapahoe Community College, 5900 S. Santa Fe Drive, Littleton, CO 80120.
